

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTION FOR GATE

1. How often do I have to complete the GATE application?  
(Associate & Bachelor, each semester and Certificate & Diploma, once per year).
2. How does this New Curriculum affect my GATE application?  
When applying for GATE select the appropriate course if you are **CONTINUING** student under the previous programme or a **NEW** Student under the new programme.

### CONTINUING STUDENTS

Continuing students for both Bachelors and Associate will see BOTH REVISED AND PREVIOUS/UN-REVISED programmes.

- a) Students who continue to be enrolled in the **previous programme MUST SELECT** the programme that carries the **letter 'D' and the phrase - (programme structure prior to 2019)** - in parenthesis.
- b) Students who continue to be enrolled in the **new programme MUST SELECT** the programme which **DOES NOT** carry the letter D and have a supporting transfer letter from Admissions department.

4. What documents to upload to GATE?

2 forms of ID, birth certificate, marriage certificate, acceptance letter/ transcript.

5. How do I access GATE funding?

Register with College, Retrieve acceptance letter, Obtain GATE ID from College GATE unit, Apply online and upload documents on GATE website.

6. When does registration commence?

Registration commences as follows

Semester One - July

Semester Two - January

7. Can I apply at home?

Yes

8. How to get back into your GATE account when you have been locked out?

Call 800-GATE or email GATE to reset account.

9. If my application was rejected by GATE, what can I do?  
Students who has exhausted GATE funding or GPA too low, is required to pay all fees.
10. Can I see at what stage my GATE application is at?  
Yes, there are stages to verify each step of the process in which a student is at which includes GATE processing, cancelled, clearance rejected, clearance verified, clearance approved, finance approved, signed, correction required, corrected.
11. What is the Means Test process?  
To upload documents to GATE online to support income such as:
- Salary
  - Self employed
  - Government Pension
  - Disability Grants
  - NIS
  - Child Support
  - Alimony
  - Rental Income
  - Allowance
  - Public Assistance
  - Scholarships/Bursaries
12. Can I get GATE for summer/ vacation classes?  
Yes, by applying through GATE
13. What is the minimum GPA to be to be eligible for GATE?  
GPA must not be lower than 2.0
14. Would GATE fund a repeat Module?  
No, student will have to be paid in full.
15. Do I need financial clearance to write exams?  
Yes, all fees must be paid before examinations.
16. Are there payment plans option available from the College?  
Yes, payment plans are available for tuition fees only. The terms are as follows;
- 25% initial payment of tuition fees payables.
  - Balance paid in three (3) equal installments over the semester.
17. What is the time frame to apply for GATE?  
Apply for GATE before semester commences: Each semester for ASD & BA students and once per year for Cert & Dip students.
