## **GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE DELEGATES**

1. Please ensure you have completed the registration process and obtained your conference confirmation via email. Kindly note that as an ONLINE delegate, access to the conference sessions will be exclusively through our Zoom Events platform. Additionally, please be aware that swag bags are limited to in-person delegates. 2. After you have successfully registered via the website, you will receive an email from Zoom Events ([noreply-zoomevents@zoom.us](mailto:noreply-zoomevents@zoom.us)) confirming your registration. You are required to log in to the Zoom Events using the same email address you used to register with.
3. You are asked to desist from sharing your Zoom credentials with anyone. Only one user can use your credentials. Additional users of your credentials will not gain access to the conference page.
4. We recommend that you log in to the Zoom Events Platform page at least fifteen (15) minutes before the start of the day's events. This is to sort any technical issues you may have prior to the start of the sessions.
5. If you have any questions during the sessions, we kindly ask that you use the "Raise Hand" feature or chat box option to get the attention of our support staff. You are also reminded to keep your microphone muted when you are not speaking. Please be mindful that onsite participants will also have the opportunity to ask questions, and the Moderator will also be facilitating their participation as well.
